On the morning of October 21, 2014, everything changed for Gary and his family. His beloved wife, Maureen, and the mother of their three children, passed peacefully in her sleep at age 50 after 11 years with breast cancer. Just days before her passing, their oncologist gave them a simple, sweet prescription: donuts. Maureen's favorite was powdered donuts. As their car's air conditioning kicked on to help with Maureen's labored breathing, powdered sugar blew everywhere. Gary and Maureen laughed—just as they always had, even in the hardest moments.

Over the past eleven years, Gary has continued to honor Maureen's memory by delivering bags of powdered donuts to meaningful places on October 21 each year.
